Hello RSS Community,

November is a busy and exciting month at our school. The Ministry has cancelled the November Literacy and Numeracy assessments. The next session for assessments will begin January 12, 2026. Our unique Remembrance Day Experience will offer a meaningful way to honour those who served. Additionally, the experience will be connected to the story of someone at our school. Our Fall athletic teams are in full swing right now, with some of the winter teams getting started with tryouts in the coming days and weeks. We will also take part in the Grade 9 National "Take Your Kid to Work Day." Graduation photos begin for our Grade 12's, and COBSS (Central Okanagan Bursary & Scholarship Society) applications will open for bursaries, awards, and scholarships. Lastly, thank you to our PAC who volunteer their time to support our students in a variety of ways.

His story reminds us of the human impact of conflict and the strength it takes to rebuild and begin anew.

- ★ GRAD PHOTO sign-up is now available on the Grad website or by going to www.artona.com. Photo sessions are available November 5th -November 23rd, with sessions from 2:00-9:00p.m on weekdays (no sessions on Mondays) and 10:00am-5:00pm for Saturday sessions. Please arrive 20 minutes BEFORE your assigned sessions to complete paperwork. Also, please be aware that there is a \$60 REFUNDABLE deposit for the photo session—the deposit will be applied to the student's account for ordering packages and may be refunded. It is important that we get photos for each graduating student-- please sign up early as dates will only be added as they are needed!

FAQ re: Grad Photos:

Q: I have booked an appointment but need to change the date or time. How do I do that?

A: You must contact Artona directly (via the website live-chat or phone) in order to make any changes to your appointment.

Q: I had school photos taken. Can I use this photo for the yearbook/composite?

A: No. We hope to have all our Grads photographed so that they can appear in the yearbook and on the composite (photo collection on the wall). ONLY GRAD PHOTOS taken with Artona can be used for these purposes (you may borrow a cap and gown elsewhere but they cannot be substituted).

Q: What should I wear?

A: Students are encouraged to wear dress clothes—people who identify as male may wear a dress shirt, with or without a tie; people who identify as female may wear either a simple blouse or dress, either with a collar or a v-neck. Please be aware that the collar of the shirt will be visible in photos. A limited number of dress shirts are in the studio should you need to borrow one.

Q: What do I need to bring with me?

A:Artona will supply a cap, gown and various commemorative items for photos (these will be sterilized between sittings). You may bring a small keepsake (sports memorabilia, etc) and, if you wish, your parents/guardians or a friend (due to space, a max 2 additional people may be accommodated).

Q: Can I bring a pet with me?

A: Yes, this year you may bring one pet with you but someone must be able to watch the animal during the rest of the appointment time.

Q: Where are the photos taken?

A: There is a mobile studio (portable) set up on the east/arena side of the building. (see photo for approximate location)

Q: How and when do I pay the deposit?

A: Please bring the \$60 sitting fee with you to your appointment. You can pay your deposit by debit/credit, or by bringing cash (exact change is required please).

Q: If I choose not to order, how do I get my deposit refunded?

A: On the proof package that is mailed to your home there will be full instructions and a timeline for refund. Please be aware that you must **RETURN THE PROOF PACKAGE** and follow the deadline in order to receive your refund. **This is part of the Artona policy, not RSS.**






