

2027 GRAD YEAR INFORMATION

Hello RSS Grad families. This letter is intended to give you information regarding the time, place and cost of the major functions for the Grade 12's in 2027. **Any events other than those listed below are NOT SANCTIONED by the school, and we advise you to use extreme caution in allowing your child to attend any non-sanctioned events.**

Please be aware that your child must be in a mathematical position to graduate in terms of earning graduation credits in order to participate in year end graduation events.

There is a \$60 **REFUNDABLE** deposit at the time of sitting with no obligation to purchase any photos. Should you decide not to order photos, you can request to have the deposit refunded back to you; for those ordering a photo package, the \$60 deposit will apply directly towards the cost of the package. **In order for Grads to be included in the Yearbook and the Composite Photo, students must have a picture taken by Artona.**

GRAD FEES

There are considerable costs associated with events being organized by RSS for student participation.
The Grad fee for 2027 is \$75.00

These fees go to, but are not limited to:

- Gown purchase and shipping
- Miscellaneous expenses during the year for grad activities (advertising, thank yous, etc.)
- Printing of invitations, tickets, programs
- AV equipment rental and security
- Decorations, flowers, lighting for ceremonies
- Graduation caps and tassels
- Music expenses, decorations and miscellaneous costs for Crystal Ball
- Rental of outside facilities (e.g. City of Kelowna Boardwalk) and audiovisual production costs
- Award photos and awards

Refund on Fees

We expect that all students who have the potential to graduate will participate in the Grad Ceremonies. Once grad gown orders are placed (mid-April) and because of the expenses incurred related to that event, there will be **No Grad Fee Refund after the grad gown order deadline.**

***Once a student participates in a school sanctioned grad event-
a refund will NOT be issued.***

- Please note that the school does not make any money by charging these fees as public schools are not-for-profit . The fees listed are for the purchase of supplies directly related to celebrating our Grads and/or rental of outside facilities.

Our first priority remains the safety of our students and staff. We have learned to provide these Grad events for our students in different ways than we had prior to the pandemic. Much of what we have learned has changed some of these experiences and improved these events for our families.
