- ★ COBSS: Beginning November 25, 2025 the Central Okanagan Bursary and Scholarship Society (COBSS) will open applications for scholarships & bursaries for the upcoming 2026/27 post-secondary year. One application opens students up to hundreds of awards. In order to apply for COBSS, students need to have attended one of the Post Secondary Prep #2 sessions that were presented on November 25/26. Grade 12 students who are taking a minimum of 6 courses this
 - year, and plan on attending post-secondary full-time starting September 2026, are eligible to apply. Application deadline is January 19, 2026 at 11:59pm. All information & instructions pertaining to COBSS, scholarships, bursaries & financial aid is available in the form of a PowerPoint titled "PSP #2" which is posted in the Grad Google classroom.

STEP 1: COLLECT REFUNDABLES



Collect your cleaned, empty containers into clear plastic bags. (approx. 36 inches tall and 30 inches wide and around 70-75 litres in capacity). They do not have to be sorted. You do not have to remove caps. You do not have to count.
